

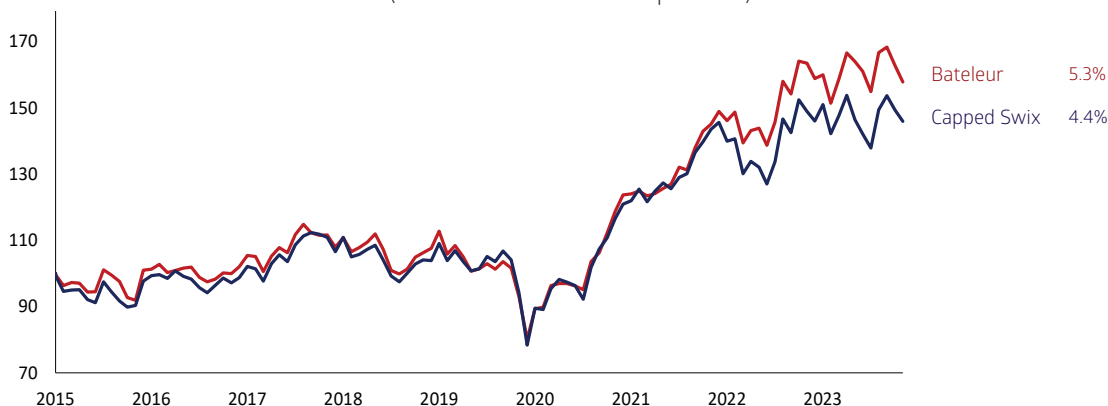
Investment objective and Investment policy

The Bateleur BCI SA Equity Fund ("the Fund") aims to generate returns in excess of the JSE Capped Shareholder Weighted All Share Index over the medium to longer term, within acceptable risk parameters.

The Fund will seek to follow an investment policy which aims to achieve capital growth in real terms.

In order to achieve this objective, the manager will invest in selected shares across all industry groups as well as across the range of large, mid and small cap shares. Whilst the Fund may invest in offshore jurisdictions, it's intended use is as a building block for investors, and accordingly only invests in South African markets. The portfolio may from time to time invest in listed and unlisted financial instruments, in accordance with the provisions of the Act, and the Regulations thereto, as amended from time to time, in order to achieve the portfolio's investment objective. The portfolio's net equity exposure will be a minimum of 80% of the portfolio's asset value.

Risk Guidance:

Low:

Generally low risk portfolios have minimal equity exposure or equity exposure, resulting in far less volatility than more aggressive mandated portfolio and in turn the probability of capital loss (permanent/temporary) is less likely. Expected potential long term investment returns could be lower over the medium to long term

Moderate:

These portfolios generally hold more equity exposure than low risk portfolios but less than high risk portfolios. In turn, the expected volatility is higher than low risk portfolios but less than high risk portfolios. The probability of losses are higher than low risk portfolios, but less than high risk portfolios. Expected potential long term investment returns could therefore be lower than high risk portfolios due to lower equity exposure, but higher than low risk portfolios.

High:

Generally these portfolios hold more equity exposure than any other risk profiled portfolios. These portfolios therefore tend to carry more volatility. Expected potential long term returns could be higher than other risk profiles, in turn potential losses of capital could be higher.

Derivatives risk:

The use of derivatives could increase overall risk by magnifying the effect of both gains and losses in a Fund. As such, large changes in value and potentially large financial losses could result.

Currency exchange risk:

Changes in the relative values of individual currencies may adversely affect the value of investments and any related income.

Equity investment risk:

Value of equities (e.g. shares) and equity-related investments may vary according to company profits and future prospects as well as more general market factors. In the event of a company default (e.g. bankruptcy), the owners of their equity rank last in terms of any financial payment from that company.

Glossary Summary

Annualised performance: Annualised performance show longer term performance rescaled to a 1 year period. Annualised performance is the average return per year over the period. Actual annual figures are available to the investor on request.

CAGR: Compound Annual Growth Rate is the mean annual growth rate of an investment over a specified period of time, longer than 1 year.

Highest & Lowest return: The highest and lowest returns for any 1 year over the period since inception have been shown.

NAV: The net asset value represents the assets of a Fund less its liabilities.

High Water Mark (HWM): The highest level of performance achieved over a specified period.
