Investment objective and Investment policy


The Bateleur Equity Prescient Fund ("the Fund") aims to generate returns in excess of the JSE Capped Shareholder Weighted All Share Index over the medium to longer term, within acceptable risk parameters.

The Fund will seek to follow an investment policy which aims to achieve capital growth in real terms.

In order to achieve this objective, the manager will invest in selected shares across all industry groups as well as across the range of large, mid and small cap shares. Whilst the Fund may invest in offshore jurisdictions, it's intended use is as a building block for investors, and accordingly only invests in South African markets.

The Fund's Total Expense Ratio (TER) reflects the percentage of the average Net Asset Value (NAV) of the portfolio that was incurred as charges, levies and fees related to the management of the portfolio. A higher TER does not necessarily imply a poor return, nor does a low TER imply a good return. The current TER cannot be regarded as an indication of future TER's. During the phase in period TER's do not include information gathered over a full year. Transaction Costs(TC) is the percentage of the value of the Fund incurred as costs relating to the buying and selling of the Fund's underlying assets. Transaction costs are a necessary cost in administering the Fund and impacts Fund returns. Risk Guidance:

Generally low risk portfolios have minimal equity exposure or equity exposure, resulting in far less volatility than more aggressive mandated portfolio and in turn the probability of capital loss (permanent/temporary) is less likely. Expected potential long term investment returns could be lower over the medium to long term

These portfolios generally hold more equity exposure than low risk portfolios but less than high risk portfolios

In turn, the expected volatility is higher than low risk portfolios but less than high risk portfolios

The probability of losses are higher than low risk portfolios, but less than high risk portfolios.

Expected potential long term investment returns could therefore be lower than high risk portfolios due to lower equity exposure, but higher than low risk portfolios.

Generally these portfolios hold more equity exposure than any other risk profiled portfolios. These portfolios therefore tend to carry more volatility.

Expected potential long term returns could be higher than other risk profiles, in turn potential losses of capital could be higher

Derivatives risk
